(2) About Western China

Definition: Western China is composed of "10+2+2" - the Southwest five provinces (Sichuan, Yunnan, Guizhou, Tibet, Chongqing), Northwest five provinces (Shanxi, Gansu, Qinghai, Xinjiang, Ningxia), as well as Inner Mongolia, Guangxi, plus the Xiangxi Autonomous Prefecture in Hunan and Enshi Autonomous Prefecture in Hubei.

Size: 6.85 million sq km, 71% of China

Population: 365 million, 29% of the Chinese, 44 ethnic minorities



1. Review and Evaluation of the Urbanization Development in China and Western China

- (3) History of the Urbanization Process in Western China Two phases:
- 1. 1949-1978: due to the constraints within and abroad, China gave priority to the development of heavy industry. The gaps between industry and agriculture, urban area and rural area had become wider in terms of development level and people's income, creating a dual structure
- II. 1978-1990s: since reform and opening-up, urbanization in Western China has greatly accelerated, the number and size of cities have increased, and the positive effects of urbanization have begun to emerge.

Siting: resource-oriented

Management: administration-led

Structure: East as priority

Circulating Development: lack

Foundation: weak

- (4) Evaluation
- 1) Backwardness of the urbanization in the West
- i. the level of urbanization is low
- ii. the number of cities is still insufficient
- iii. the structure of cities is imbalanced
- 2) Great gap between the East and the West
- i. the gap in the size of economy between East and West is growing
- ii. the central cities in the West are becoming economically relatively weaker than those in the East
- iii. investment climate in the West is far worse than that in the East
- 3) The overall less openness of Western China



2. Challenges in Urbanization Development

Major challenges:

- 1.adverse natural conditions
- 2.fragile ecological environment
- 3.poor infrastructure (transportation/communication)
- 4. Constraints exerted by household registration system
- 5.low degree of market economy
- 6.less qualified human resources

Greater challenges:

- 7. defects of driving mechanism of urbanization
- 8.still at groping stage on coordinated development
