



ABOUT THE ICS-HYI FELLOWSHIP

The Institute of Chinese Studies (ICS) – Harvard-Yenching Institute (HYI) joint scholarship program for registered doctoral students in Indian Universities was started in 2013 for promoting multi-disciplinary research on China in India. The fellowship aims to create an independent and niche scholarship by supporting students for a period of two to three years to develop Chinese language capability as well as research skills. Currently the fellowship has supported nine research scholars, three who have completed their doctoral submissions.
